Why are regular check-ups so important?



You should always visit your dentist at least once every six months for a thorough check-up, but why is this so important?

More than half of UK adults haven't had a check-up in the last two years, and more than a quarter only visit when there's an issue. Is it any wonder, then, that 31% of adults have tooth decay, 66% have visible plaque, and 29% suffer from regular pain?

Poor oral health can also increase your risk of developing a range of other health conditions.

Those with moderate to severe gum disease have a 69% higher risk of developing type 2
diabetes which, in turn, increases their risk of heart and circulatory disease.

Mouth cancer screenings are a vital part of routine check-ups, as spotting the early signs can boost survival rates from 50% to 90%.

Check-ups help us to detect dental development problems early on in a child's life and intervene to reduce the need for braces later in life.
