### Clinical Showcase

Every newsletter we showcase a clinical case, in this one would like to share a recent case we completed at Dental Rooms. At first glance, it may appear to be a simple replacement of an upper lateral incisor with an implant. However, this was a young patient with a high aesthetic demand, severe tooth-wear and a challenging occlusal scheme.









- a) Presenting Complaint: Wobbly Tooth after hitting it against a door.
- b) Diagnosis: Vertically fractured UR2, Localised anterior severe tooth wear, etiology predominantly attrition, abrasion and erosion
- c) Treatment Options: Tooth wear: Stabilise and Monitor, restore aetiology is corrected using either composite or ceramic restorations.

**UR2**: Extractions and replacement

- d) Final Plan:
- 1) Extractions of UR2 and immediate placement of a 4.3 RP Nobel Implant with Xenograft Bone augmentation and chairside provisional restoration
- 2) Prevention, improve oral hygiene
- 3) Tooth Whitening
- 4) Composite Build- ups at increased OVD to restore Tooth proportion and mutually protective occlusion; using Direct composite placed with injection moulding technique.
- 5) Restoration of UR2 implant with screw retained zirconia crown
- 6) Provision of an occlusal stabilisation splint.

#### e) Treatment Discussion/Complications

- 1) Extraction of vertically fractured tooth and preservation of buccal bite
- 2) Immediate placement of an implant
- 3) Conservative management of tooth wear with high aesthetic demand
- 4) Chairside provisional

It was key to educate the patient in understanding the benefits of idealising the occlusal scheme to make the long term prognosis of an implant restoration more favourable. This would also mean we would not have to make an aesthetic compromise for the restoration, and allowed for an improvement in proportion and symmetry of the teeth. We planned an immediate implant to replace the UR2; then soon after this we performed a localised anterior composite rehabilitation, utilising the Dahl concept as the implant was osseo-integrating. Below is a detailed case description.
